**Approval of Minutes**

**President's Report:** PTC Board members for 20-21: Kim Carbonneau and Julie Lerch Presidents, Stephanie Furlong and Jay Lerch Vice Presidents, Alicia Cernauske Secretary, Lauren Polzin Treasurer; Board is encouraged by administration to bring our school together as a community whether in-person or virtually, PTC introductions as a group

**Treasurer's Report:** See under new business

**Principal's Report** – Mrs. Burnett: 89 is moving forward with in-person option; for those who chose remote, we are working hard to make the remote program robust; Kindergarten screening was today-masks were not a problem; staff has been working since March on every school day plan for 20-21; teachers came in during the summer for 1-4 days aligning curriculum to gather resources for in person and remote; Curriculum should be aligned between home and in person; teachers aligned assessments, and recorded lessons; PTC met during the summer to determine how to make school look more like typical school; created outdoor classroom spaces for mask breaks; PTC purchased sun shade sails for shaded areas for kids; per email today, 89 will follow area health and safety recommendations (IDPH); beach towels added to supply list; parents can model mask wearing ahead of time; videos will be sent from school to encourage new school policy of masks

**Faculty Report – Ms. Martie** and Ms. Clarey: Teachers are so excited to have the kids back or over zoom, teachers appreciate the outdoor classroom spaces;

Can pictures be sent electronically? - b. **School Pictures:** not sure when it will happen this year
- c. **Assemblies:** may be virtually this year
- d. **Communications:** Jim Woods maintains PTC website (arborviewptc.org); replacement needed for next year; if any committee has an announcement to post, go to the PTC website, enter your information, and Jim will post it. Meeting minutes are on there, committee information; PTC Facebook page and Twitter; weekly newsletter goes out on Friday from Mrs. Burnett
- e. **Spirit Wear:** Keri Galas will launch new Spirit Wear; welcome anyone who wants to help
- f. **Halloween Harvest:** not sure how we can do a safe program this year; further discussion at September meeting; Back to School Bash cancelled; Halloween Harvest Idea from Tom - "Use driveways for different events or activities. Maybe a block in Valley View that has more AV families than others. Block the street and have families walk up and down the street, stopping at the driveways with an activity. Food has it's own driveway."
- g. **Room Parents:** Still trying to figure out how to organize this; working with Debbie Damato to make necessary changes due to current policies; how to include remote learners as well?

- a. **Scouts:** Boy Scouts- lots of hikes, scouts track their miles; Girl Scouts- Little Free Library near AV in the Fall; Per Keri: "Scouts are doing a fishing thing on the 16th and all interested in scouts are welcome to attend."

- c. **New Student/Family Welcome to Arbor View:** Back to School Swag: new students and K's will get a surprise dropped off at their homes to welcome to AV; order form for returning students (t-shirts and yard signs);
- d. **Question:** Possibility of AV masks for purchase?  
Can be ordered through Spirit Wear; PTC felt mask fit was personal so did not purchase for all.
- e. **Question:** Can we have extra signs for purchase on the first day of school?  
Will have to figure out how we can do that with social distancing policies at AV
